I am cycling from Tynemouth to Holy Island starting 20th June 2025, to raise funds for The Bay Foodbank. This is one of the largest independent foodbanks in the country and the only foodbank serving the entirety of North Tyneside. They provide emergency parcels to those experiencing crisis in North Tyneside. A typical day will see them providing 40-45 emergency parcels, directly supporting more than 90 people.
